When you need to clean up your room, have you ever shoved your stuff under the bed instead of putting it away?

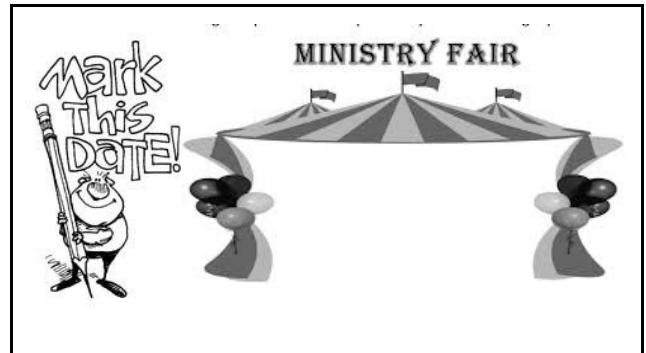
Even though having a clean room

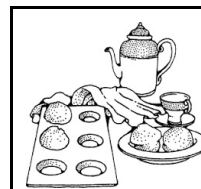
St. Pius X Parish will hold a Ministry Fair next weekend, October 20 and 21, 2018 after the Masses in the Parish Hall.
